# Banquet

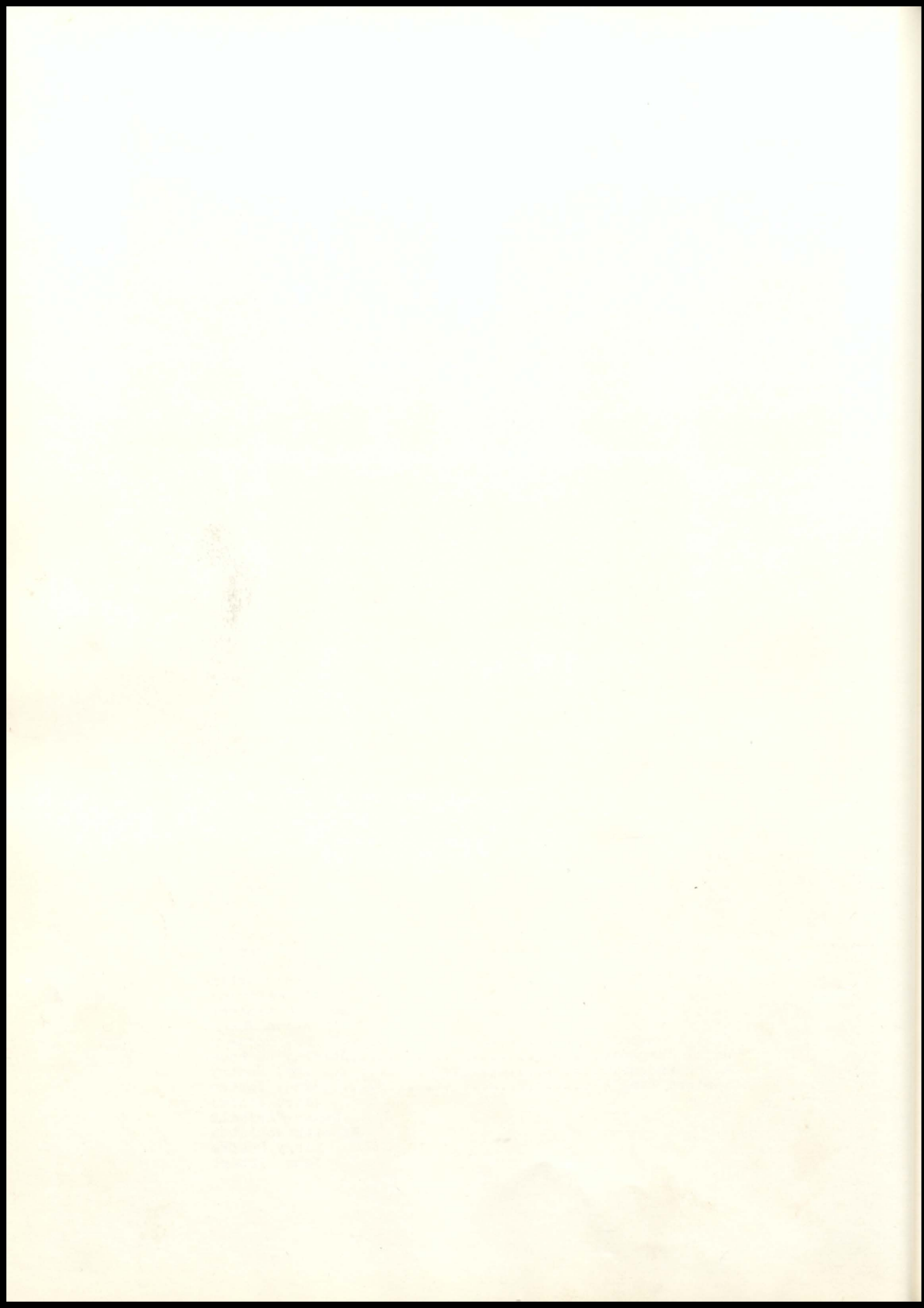


The Junior-Senior Banquet was held at the high school gym, Saturday, April 24, 1954.

I, Bill Burns do will and bequeath my ability to be a grocery boy to you Dwayne Salzkorn. It may help you be the future Mr. Universe.

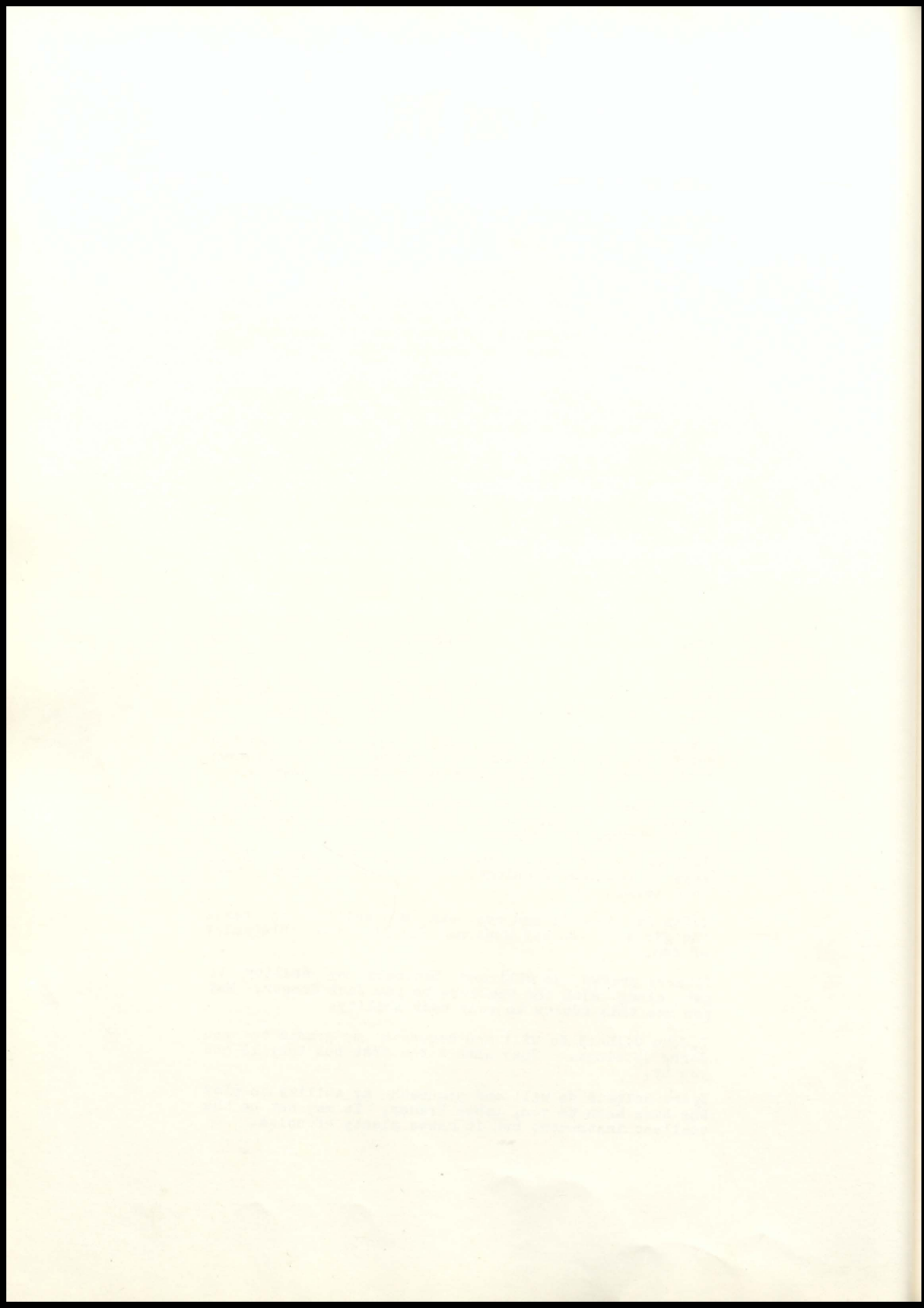
I, Jerry Cooper do will and bequeath my easy going ways to you Judy Jennings. Here's hoping you have good luck.

I, Joe Sweeney do will and bequeath my chest to you Jim DeBoom. Jim it may feel awkward for a while but you'll get use to it.

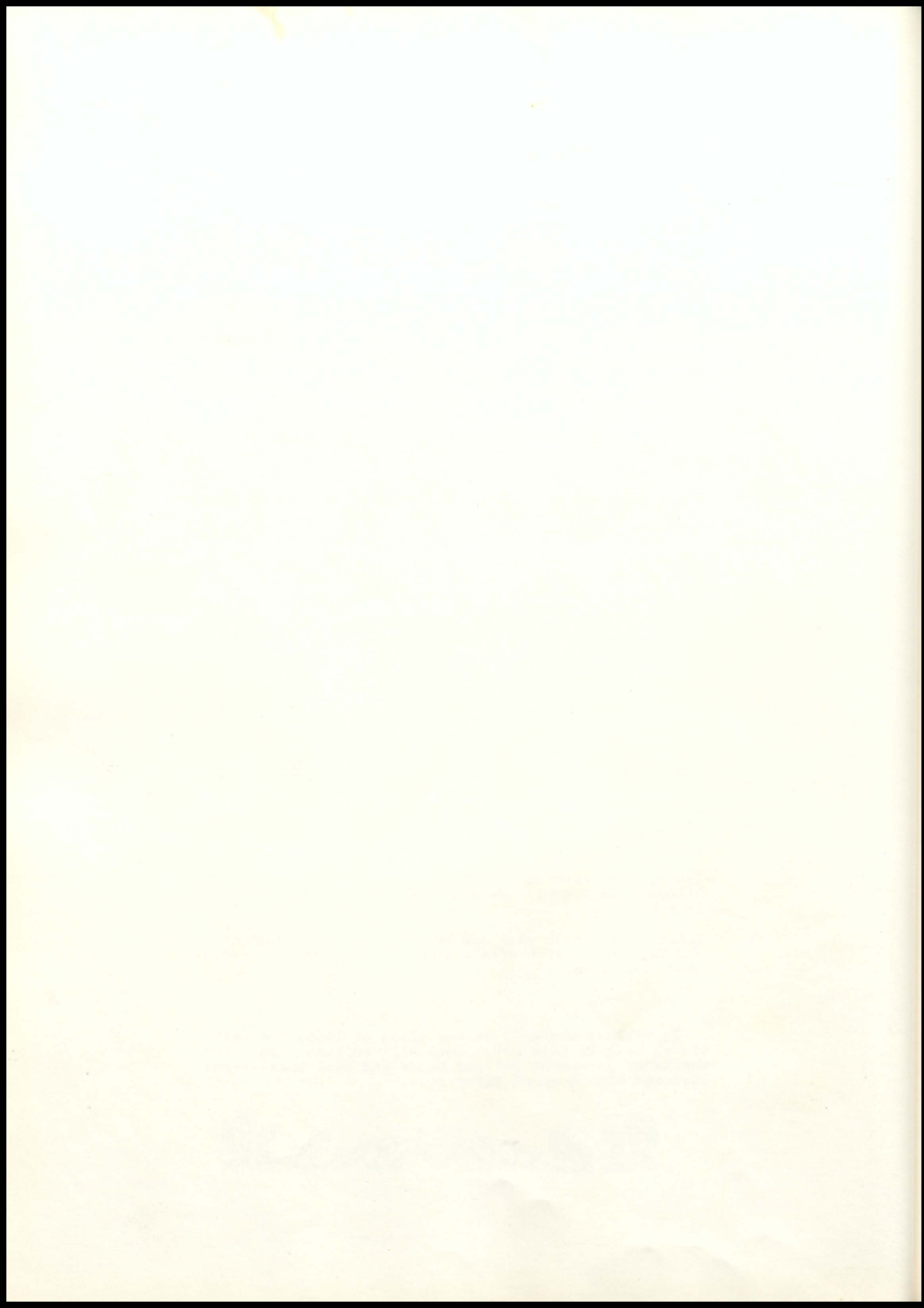

## Junior Activities

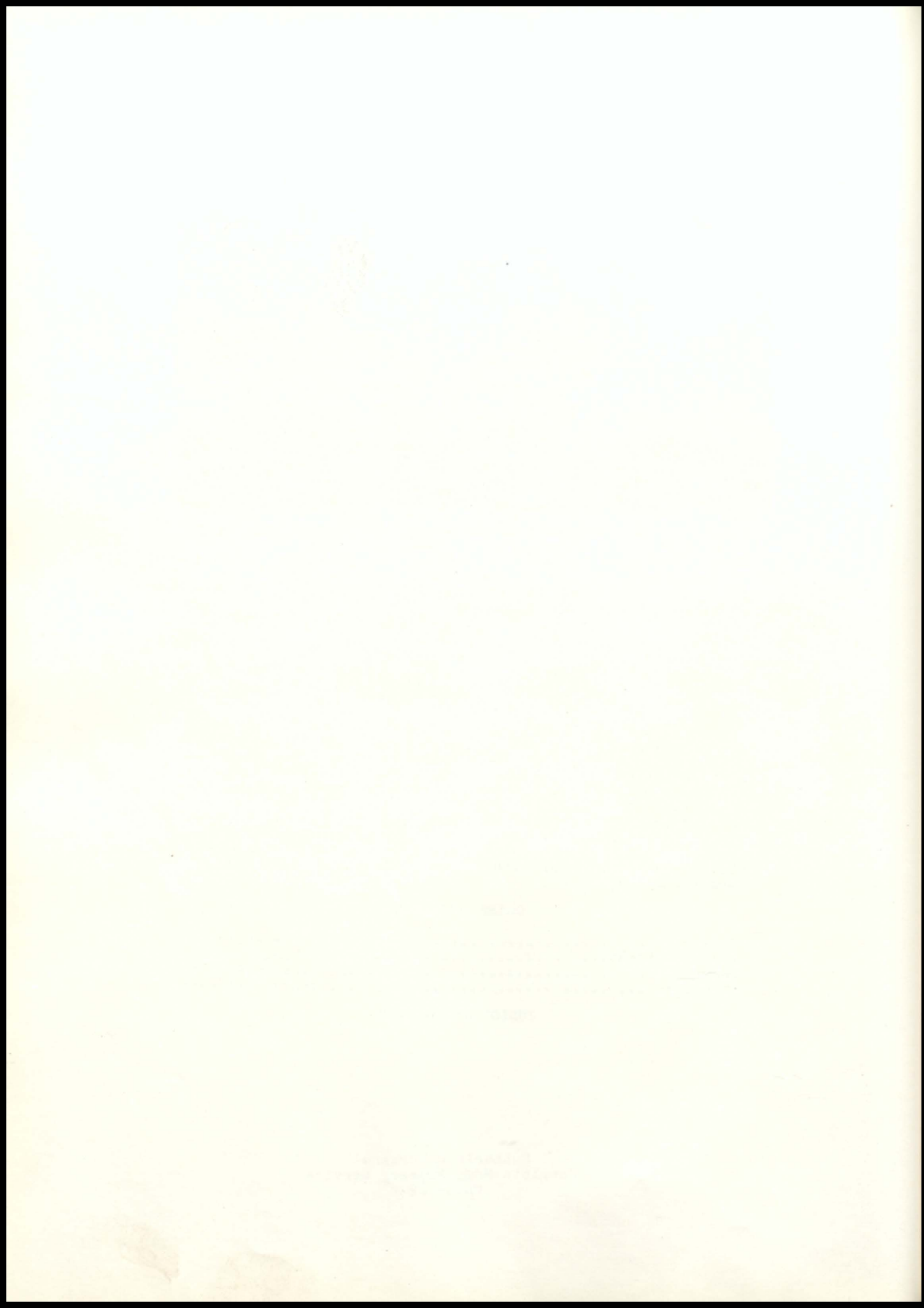

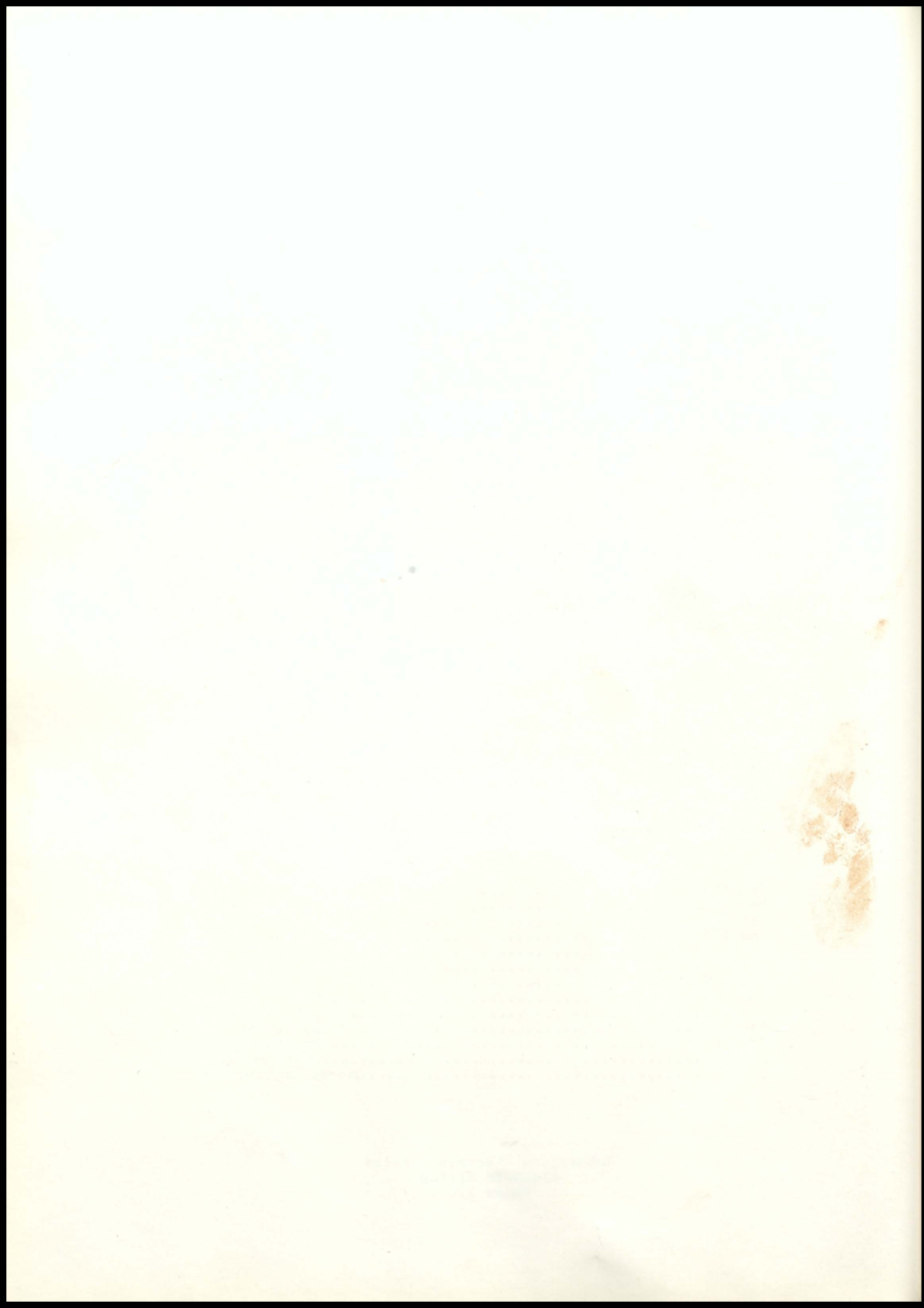
## "DESPERATE AMBROSE"
