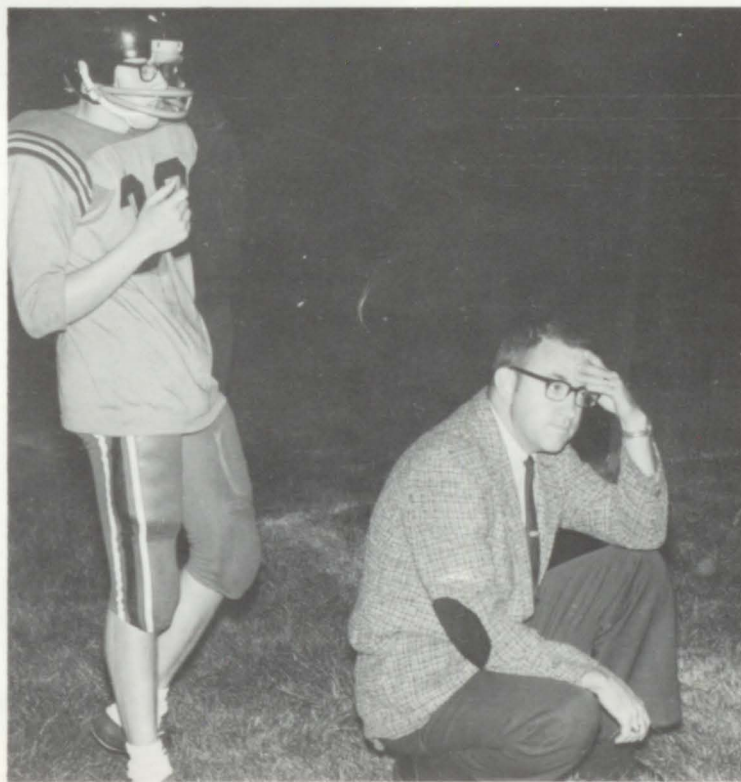
ACTION SHOTS
