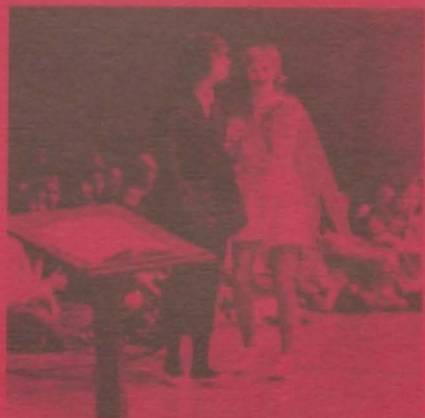
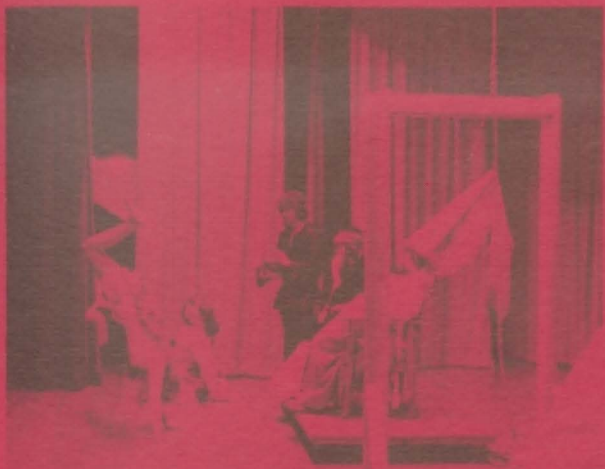
The Drama Class once again as they have done for the past two years, put on their Children's Play. This year the play that was chosen was, "The Princess and The Pea."
