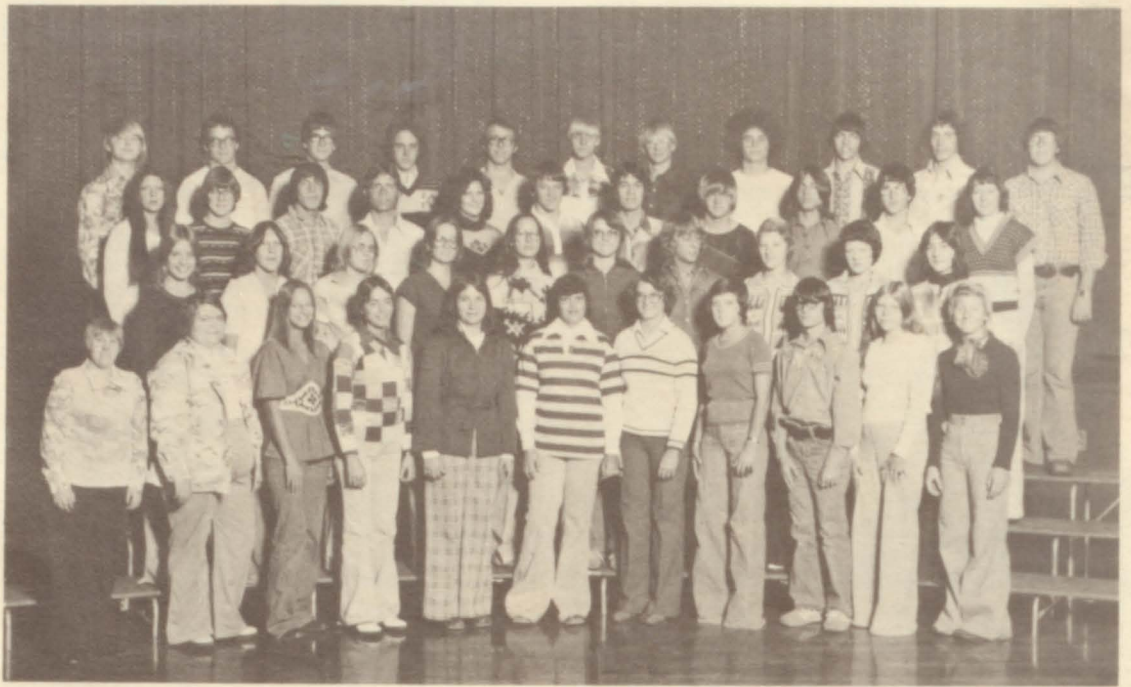
After a few minutes, Con-

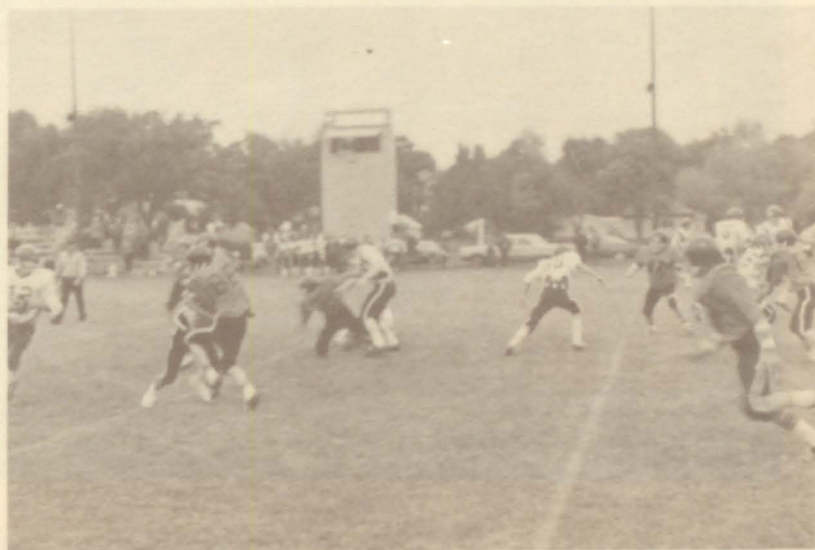

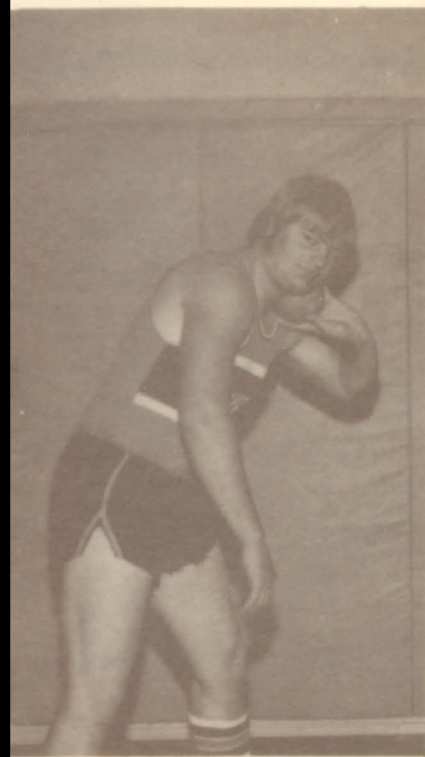


Two things Tiger Track Teams have been known for over the years, are its high point total and its messy camp. This year was no exception.
