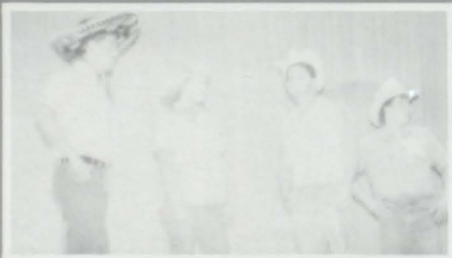
# A SPLASH OF FASHION

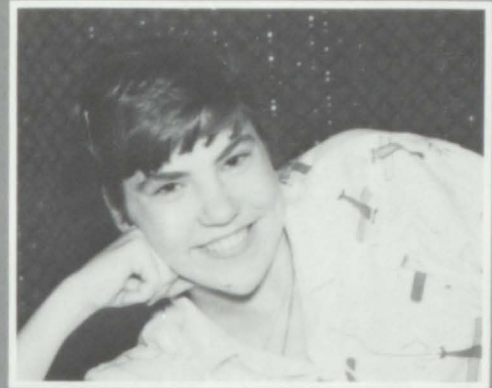

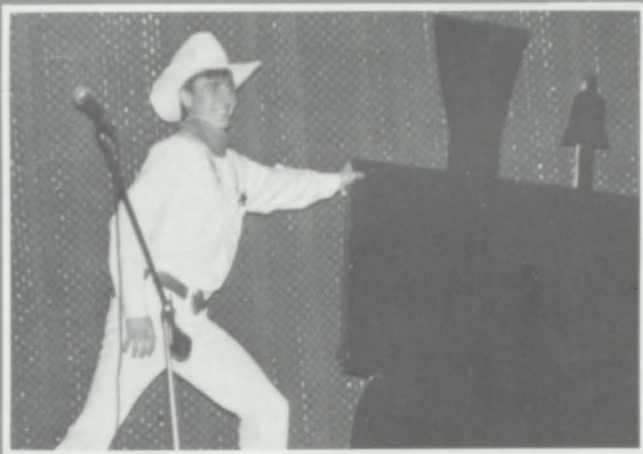

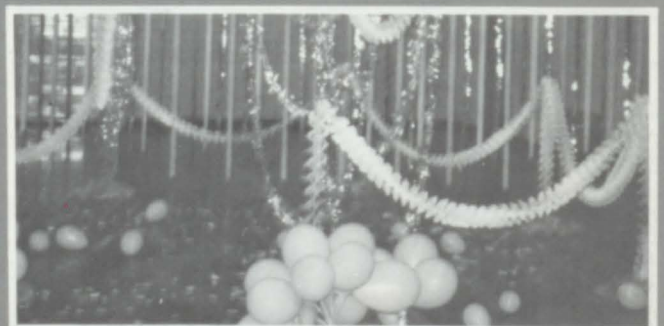


# PROM-"WILL YOU STILL LOVE ME"



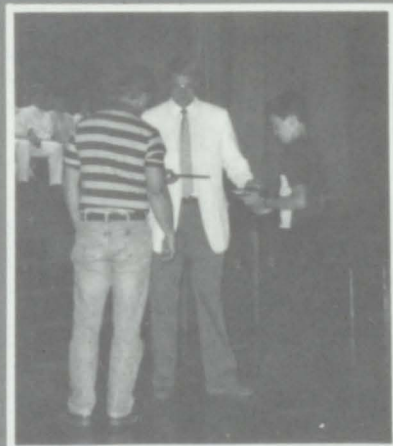

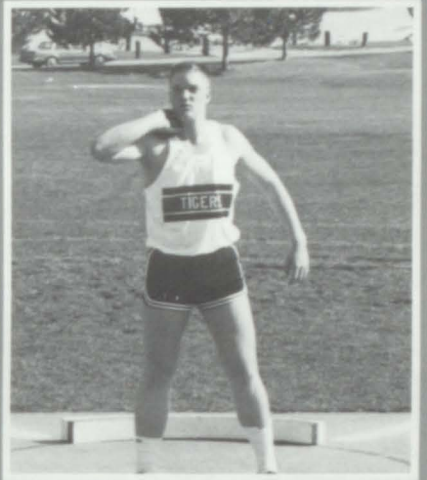
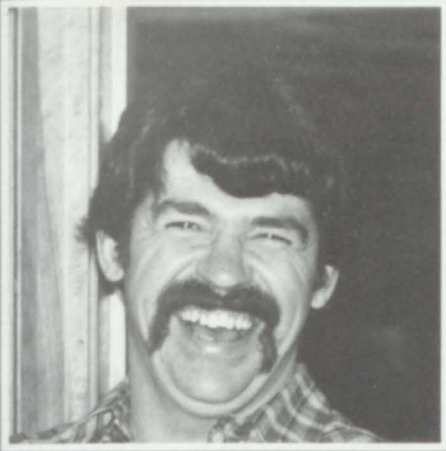


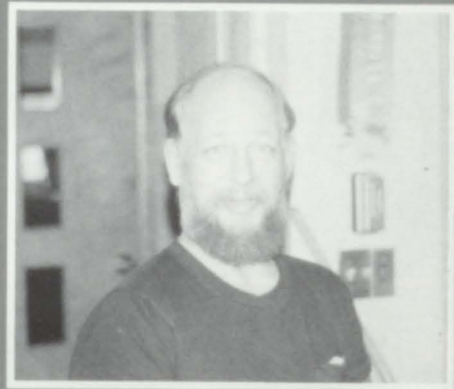
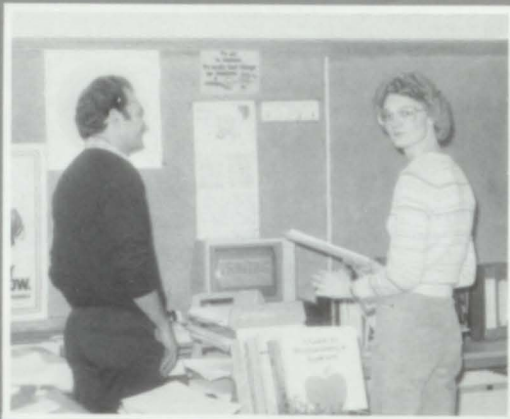
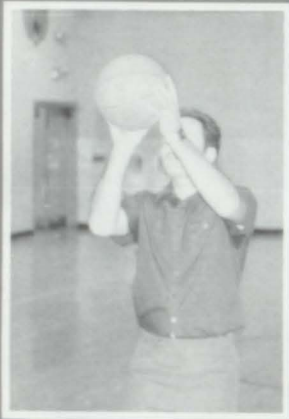
# NEWSPAPER STAFF
