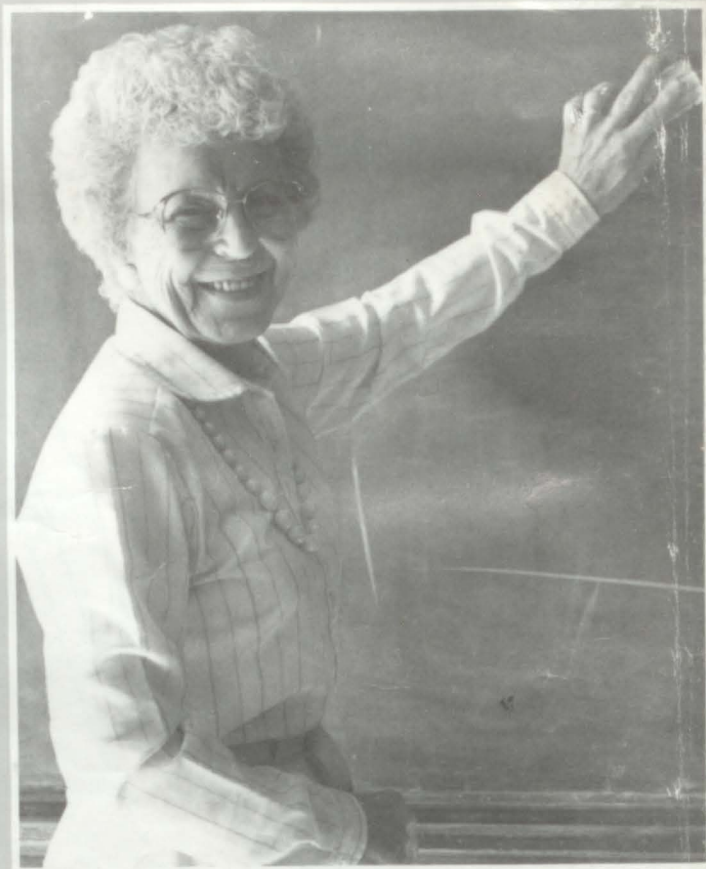


Dedication

Maricarmen's natural home is Merida Yucatan Mexico, which is located in the southern part of Mexico. Merida is a city of roughly one million people.

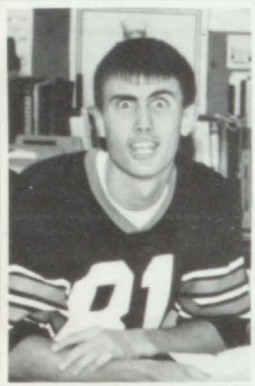

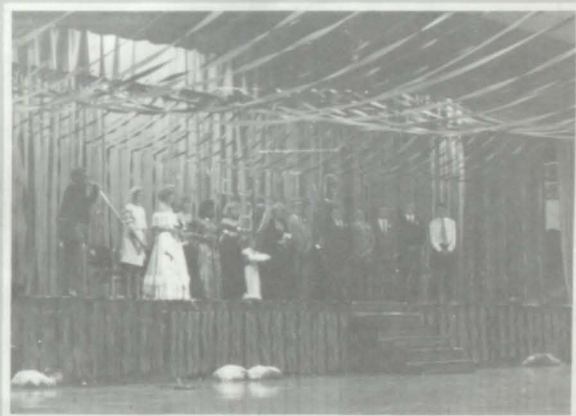

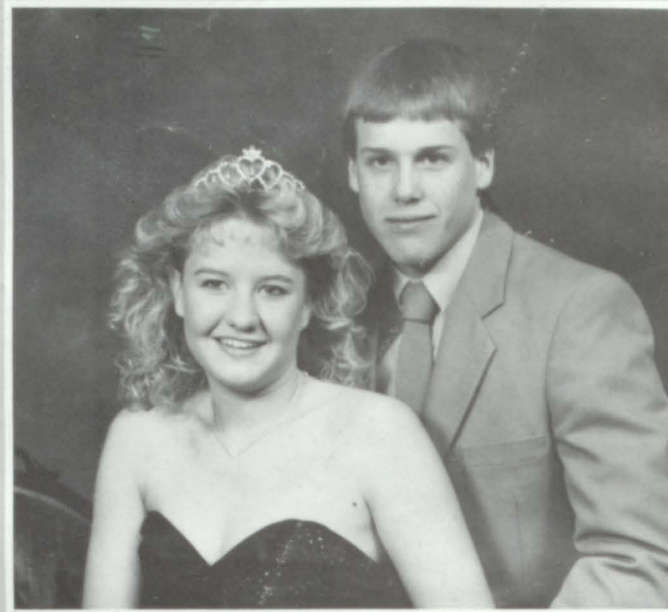

Jons Gallery started taking pictures around 7:30pm. This year was the first year we've had a grand march and it was a big success.

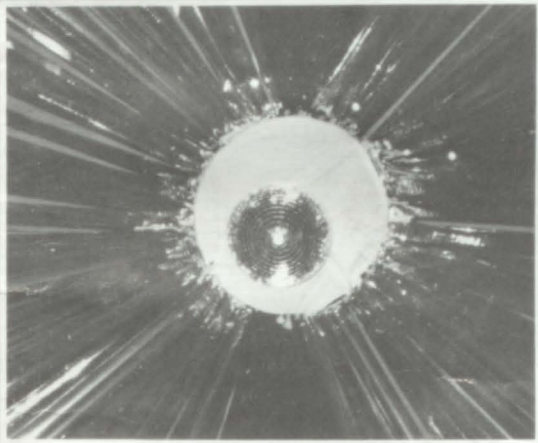

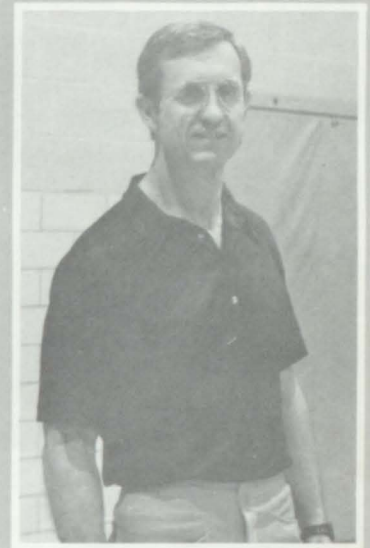






Athletics
