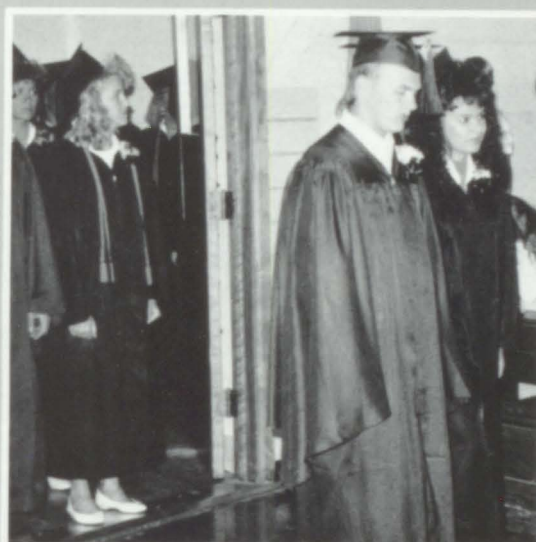
FOREIGN EXCHANGE STUDENT

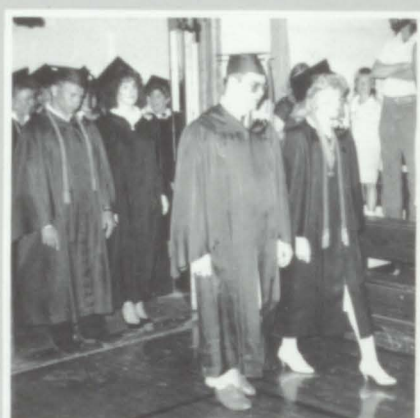
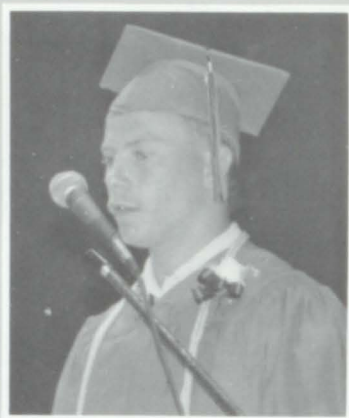
While attending classes here at S.H.S. she took Spanish, Typing, Art, Beginning Computer, History and Algebra II. She told us that Art was her favorite class.

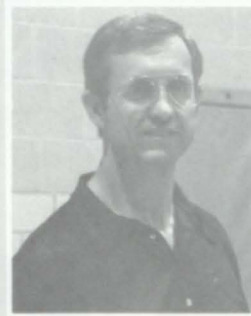
FACULTY

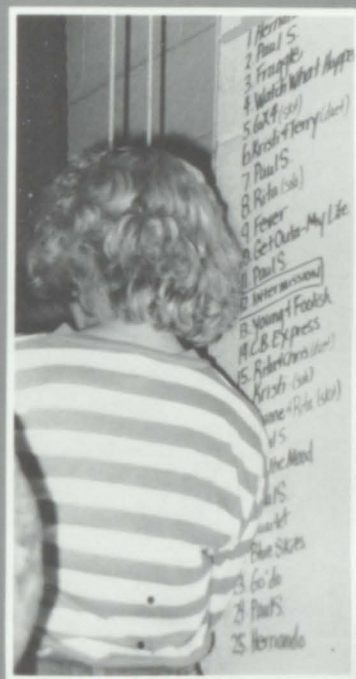
SWING SHOW "88"

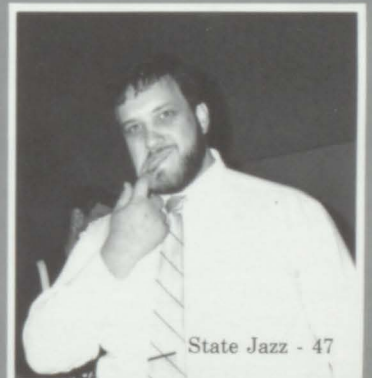
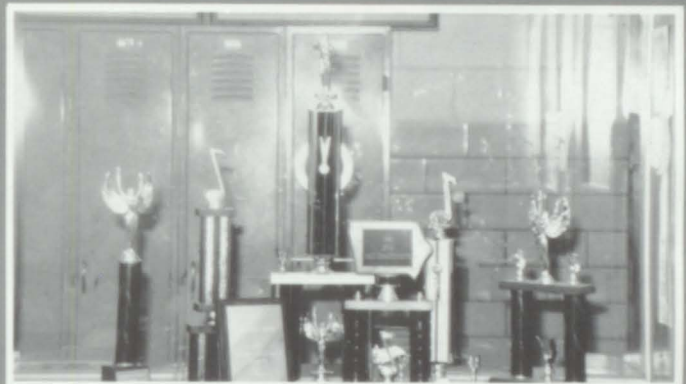
WHEN IT MEANS 10 STRAIGHT YEARS TO STATE!
